










## **SCHOLARSHIP**



- contribution to cover your travelling and housing costs
- granted automatically based on the submission and evaluation of all required documents and signing the Erasmus Agreement
- sent in one amount before the start of the mobility







- The one-off contribution of EUR 50 for using an environmentally friendlier way of transport
- Eligible means of transport to / from the receiving foreign institution are **train**, **bus**, **boat or shared car**
- The contribution is sent after the end of the mobility and after providing the European Office RUK the accounting document (tickets, proof of payment...)
- Must be specified in WebApps in advance

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

#### **Required documents:**

- CV in English (max. 1-2 pages)
- Motivation letter in English demonstrating how the short-stay mobility relates to the study field (max. 1 page)
- Documentation of language proficiency (preferably a language certificate)
- Information of study results at the FSV (SIS results with indicated GPA)
- Information on an estimated dates of a short-term mobility, name of a pre-arranged organization and the name, telephone number and email of a contact person
- Approval of a short-stay mobility by the Academic tutor



## OUTGOING PROCESS via webapps

- fill in the personal information
- create Learning Agreement (signed by all three parties)
- provide Acceptance/ Invitation Letter

• finishing the process at European Office CU by signing the Erasmus Financial Agreement




## Sasakawa Young Leaders Fellowship Fund (SYLFF)

- full-time PhD student (maximum 3rd year)
- enrolled in studies at Charles University






