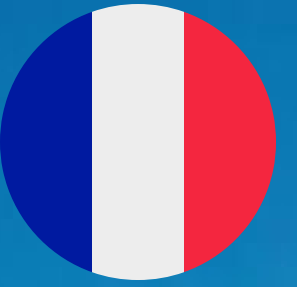
Green Erasmus

- Must be specified in WebApps in advance

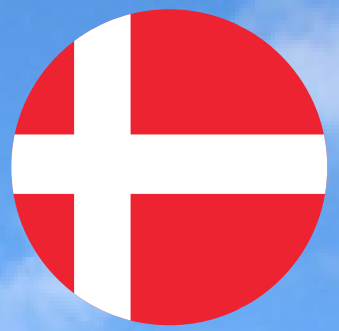

APPLICATION PROCESS

Required documents:

- **CV in English (max. 1-2 pages)**
- **Motivation letter in English demonstrating how the short-stay mobility relates to the study field (max. 1 page)**
- **Documentation of language proficiency (preferably a language certificate)**
- **Information of study results at the FSV (SIS results with indicated GPA)**
- **Information on an estimated dates of a short-term mobility, name of a pre-arranged organization and the name, telephone number and email of a contact person**
- **Approval of a short-stay mobility by the Academic tutor**

About the programme

The **Europaeum Scholars Programme** is taken alongside a doctorate in 7-8 intensive modules, each of 3-5 days, in universities across Europe. The modules include seminars, debates and workshops with leading academics and practitioners; professional skills training; and substantial teamwork. Over the two years, the Scholars operate in small multidisciplinary groups on a project designed and conducted entirely by them to "make Europe a better place". The final proposals are evaluated by a panel of experts and presented at an international conference.
