#### **General Information**

Master in Area Studies (MAS) is an interdisciplinary two-year master's program that focuses on either Europe, Eurasia or North America's modern history and current developments. The program provides a detailed and systematic understanding of the area's current challenges. The main aim of MAS is to educate area studies specialists to be able to adapt easily to a multicultural and multidisciplinary environment. Students have the opportunity to compile their own curriculum to reflect their perso-nal interests, or they may choose from two sugges-ted study tracks:

**The US and Global Affairs** track introduces students to skills essential for the analysis of US foreign policy, its structural underpinnings and their impact across the globe and in various policy fields.

**Transition and Integration in Europe** track focuses on the study of the latest development of the post-communist European countries with respect to the transition from the communist society and integration into the Euro-Atlantic structures.
